Dress Code:

Good taste* in proper attire for Members, Spouses, Juniors and Guests at the Club should be followed at all times. Jeans or denim of any type are not permitted on the club premises.

The definition of "jeans" is; pants of material made from denim (a durable twilled cotton fabric) regardless of color, style or cost.

MEMBERS & EVENT HOSTS' ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUEST'S ATTIRE AT ALL TIMES.

Banquet Events: The event host is responsible for informing *all guests and vendors* of the Club's dress code. The dress code applies *at all times* before, during, and after your event.

Suit Jackets/Sports Coats *are not* required attire for men for banquet events. However, we do suggest you advise your guests that appropriate attire such as collared shirts, and no open toed shoes or hats (men only) are suggested when attending any Club function.

The Club's dress code must be included on all invitations, flyers, and/or any printed materials going out to your guests.
